Your legacy will transform Jewish people's lives

Your legacy gift will ensure that current and future generations of Jewish people will hear about Jesus and be saved

It is good for all people of all ages to make a will and keep it updated. Having an up-to-date will offers you peace of mind for the future. It is the only way to ensure that you are able to provide for your loved ones, as well as the causes you hold close to your heart.

Making a will can be simple and straightforward. **We recommend you have it written by a solicitor who can give further advice and make sure it is legally valid.**

Types of legacy gifts

Remembering International Mission to Jewish People in your will is a wonderful way to invest in our work among Jewish people. You can leave a legacy gift to us in the following ways:

A Pecuniary Gift: a legal term for a specified sum of money. It is worth noting that the value of a pecuniary gift will decrease over time due to inflation.

A Residuary Gift: all or a part of what remains after your other legacies and legal expenses have been paid.

A Specific Gift: This is a particular item of value left in your will, for example shares, property, life insurance policies or jewellery.
